CRUCOGSA – The Physical Behaviour of Crude Oil Influencing its Carriage by Sea

This report records a preliminary evaluation and review of analytical data relating to the three forms of crude oil, namely, vapour, liquid and sludge, together with the data reported by the participating vessels relating to parameters affecting the likely behaviour of the specific crude oil/s during their transportation. The publication also includes equations and models that can be used during the transportation of crude oils that include an equation to calculate the vapour pressure that will be obtained from the crude oil in cargo tanks, a cargo temperature model to find out if the cargo is likely to create problems during discharge or COWing and advices relating to the Cloud Point temperature of crude oils generally. Associated with the publication is the CRUCOGSA database that allows searching for specific data relating to the crude oils tested and carried during the period of the project and this can also supply actual information experienced by the vessels during the transportation of the crude oil.
