<i>Quality System Certification Scheme</i> SAFER SHIPPING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor CSR for effectiveness, consistency and transparency • Offer assistance to flag States that remain on PSC black lists • Provide report in 2008 to expand and improve the IACS Quality Certification System • Work towards reducing the number of IACS classed vessels detained by PSC, particularly for class-related deficiencies
